- 🐾 The Carla Cumming Sojonky Adoption Centre, which houses the BVSPCA, was built in 2007
- 🐾 We are Canada's *first* no-kill, no-cage facility
- 🐾 Surrender fees, grants, and fundraising cover 27% of our expenses. We need your support as the remaining 73% relies on donations from people like you to help us continue to change lives.
- 🐾 We have 2.2 acres of provincially leased land which our dogs have access to



OUR GOALS

Our primary goals are to provide excellent care, and to improve programs and services.

Over the last 10 years, the average length of stay for dogs and cats in shelters has increased from ~5 weeks to over 3 months. Because we are a no-kill shelter, we receive many animals with complex behaviour or medical issues, who might be euthanized elsewhere. It is not uncommon for animals in our care to stay with us for over a year.

In spite of this rise, we have found forever homes for all these animals. To meet our goals, we need funds to respond to escalating demands, without compromising individual care to the animals we save. Additionally, as cases become more complex, we need to ensure we have qualified trainers and medical professionals capable of developing individualized training/medical plans for each dog or cat.

VOLUNTEER

PROGRAMS

We offer various educational programs to those in our community, including dog training classes such as Puppy Socialization, Essential Life Skills, and Agility.
